Cherie Jimenez

Director of the Eva Center



Cherie Jimenez founded the Eva Center in 2006. This project was created in response to the overwhelming need to assist women in the complex process of exiting out of commercial sexual exploitation.

The insights Cheri gained over two decades in “the life” including how easy it is for smart and vulnerable women to slip into prostitution and how hard it is to get out, have led to Jimenez’ calling.

In the beginning of this year Cheri established one of the only 3 safe houses in greater Boston, for the number of women wanting to get out of the sex trade.
